- Third-party interface with MDS analyzer programs allows you to send data to third-party vendors with one click. These vendors send back an analysis report of the MDS which you can review without leaving the MDS.
- On each MDS form, Prospective Payment System (PPS) or Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act (OBRA), the Interim Payment Assessment (IPA)

- review form is available. This tool allows you to quickly review the impact on PDPM of any changes in a resident's condition.
- MDS questions in MatrixCare identify how data from individual questions are used. Questions are flagged for Care Area Assessments, Resource Utilization Groups (RUGS), Patient driven payment model (PDPM) and Quality Measures. The MDS answers related to Care Area Assessment will pre-fill to CAA forms as they are created.

With MatrixCare, completed MDS data autopopulates forms for facility matrix and resident census and conditions reports. The same data is also used for quality measuring and reporting programs, streamlining report submissions and eliminating duplicate documentation.
