



MyScrubber for OASIS: Strengthen assessments at the point of care

Real-time review helping improve accuracy, compliance, and confident documentation



MyScrubber for OASIS is a data-driven tool that reviews OASIS assessments in real time and can help identify potential errors, inconsistencies, ICD-10 coding issues, and items that influence case mix, reimbursement, quality outcomes, and process measures so teams can address them before submission.

It's designed to support efforts to strengthen documentation accuracy and compliance while streamlining quality review, helping agencies collect accurate patient data, complete stronger assessments, and ultimately maximize the impact of their care.



How it works

- > Clinicians can complete OASIS scrubbing on the iPad, whether connected or disconnected
- > No internet connection is needed to run the scrub or receive results for updating the assessment
- > Alerts and recommendations are integrated directly into the assessment, helping clinicians quickly review what needs attention and make updates
- > Clinicians can accept or decline recommendations, supporting regulatory compliance by ensuring the original clinician acknowledges documentation changes
- > Supports different workflow preferences, allowing clinicians to review as a full page or by assessment section
- > Alerts are color-coded and ordered by severity to help with prioritization
- > Areas of Impact are marked with icons that show how each alert influences key agency priorities, displayed in the alert header to guide decision-making
- > Provides access to a detailed patient report listing all alerts and recommendations, along with additional analysis on visits, scoring, payment, medication, and diagnosis data

Why it matters for your agency

Process measure: Identifies items included in the Home Health Quality Process Measure.

Avoidable event: Identifies item responses that indicate an avoidable event or have the potential to lead to one if no action or improvement occurs before the end of the episode.

Reimbursement: Identifies items related to case mix scoring and payment.

Potential mismatch between OASIS and plan of care: Identifies a potential or critical data conflict within the plan of care or between the plan of care and OASIS.

OASIS/Coding error: Identifies a known or confirmed error in an OASIS response or diagnosis code; all alerts with this icon are critical, as the issue is confirmed and needs to be resolved.

Value-based purchasing (VBP) measure: Identifies items included in VBP measures.

STAR rating: Identifies items included in the Quality of Patient Care Star Rating measures.

Home Health Compare (HHC): Identifies OASIS questions included in HHC publicly reported measures.

Regulatory alert: Indicates a decline in an OASIS item or outcome measure.

Shows improvement: Indicates an improvement in an OASIS item or outcome measure.

Shows decline: Indicates a decline in an OASIS item or outcome measure.
